The GutterDrainer system is an all season plastic channel placed along the bottom of the gutter. The water flows underneath into the channel while debris is blocked out. The flow is rushed to the outlet, preventing gutter overflow.

Some debris may accumulate, but the wind can blow it off the smooth plastic surfaces, and the water will always drain.

With GutterDrainer, cleaning is not necessary. GutterDrainer blocks out snow, absorbs heat from the sun, and keeps the channel open.


NOTES: Be sure your gutters and downspouts are clean. Gutter Drainer® installs best at 40° F and above & can be easily cut with scissors. Gutter Drainer® must be installed in the entire gutter length(s).

TOOLS REQUIRED:

- Standard Scissors
- Masking Tape
- Tape Measure
- · Sheet Metal Screws (for corners, not provided)

METHOD:

STEP 1: Unroll Gutter Drainer® and cut into 10' to 15' lengths.



STEP 2: Prefold Gutter Drainer® at creases to form a channel. Overfold and tape one end flat as per 1. Make sure shiny side is out!


STEP 3: Slide into gutter covering the downspouts. Be sure to seat Gutter Drainer® to the bottom of the gutter with shiny side up as shown in 2.


STEP 4: Expansion joints are required every 10' to a maximum of 15'. Overlap Gutter Drainer® 6" to provide expansion joint as shown in **3**. Do not put Hold Down Clips in the overlap region!

NOTE: Allow clearance from both ends of gutter of approx. 1/2".



STEP 5: CORNERS (if required). Cut two 12" lengths of Gutter Drainer® and notch ends as show in **4**. Overlap and secure with sheet metal screw (not provided). Place corner assembly in gutter under ends of Gutter Drainer® 6, allowing 6" overlap for expansion. Do not put Hold Down Clips in the overlap region!





STEP 6: Place (provided) Hold Down Clips starting 2" from the ends and approx. at 2' intervals and 4" from all overlaps. See **3** & **5**. It works best to insert clips all the way down the back of gutter, (6a). Then compress and place other end in the bottom of front of gutter, (6b). Hold Down Clips properly installed should fit over Gutter Drainer® as in (6c).
